OUR STRATEGIES

Kwinana Blue Jays Baseball Club Inc. works collaboratively with all stakeholders including its members, sponsors/partners, local council and baseball governing body in WA to ensure any legal or any other compliance obligations are met through the following key strategies:

- Ensuring equipment utilised and supplied by the club complies with applicable standards
- Health, Safety and Environment is communicated/discussed at club committee meetings
- Implementation of an injury/incident reporting process
- Ensure that adequate public liability and player insurance is available as required by the baseball governing body in WA
- Coaches to undertake inspections of grounds prior to commencement of training and games to ensure potential hazards are identified and controlled
- Actively promote health knowledge and awareness at the club
- Actively promote the use of stretching and warm ups at training and game days
- Maintain a fully stocked first aid kit for home games and have members at the club who hold current first aid qualifications
- Actively promote the use of protective equipment during training and game play
- Provide a designated smoking area away from members
- Encourage players whom sustain an injury to seek medical clearance prior to returning
- Maintain a register of all emergency contact numbers for each player
- Erect warning signage at home ground as required
- Actively promote recycling and waste segregation practices
- Adhere to any and all obligations relating to health, safety and environment from local council
- Adhere to any and all obligations relating to health, safety and environment from baseball governing body in WA
